



Beginning Quilt Class Supply List

Sewing Machine:

A sewing machine will be needed for the class. If a sewing machine is needed for short term use, the Hailey Library has sewing machines available to check out.

The 5 Bee Quilters Guild members have five sewing machines to loan.

There is a beginning sewing Bernette 35 sewing machine on sale through the Twin Falls Sewing Center at 157 Main Avenue West for \$300, usually \$399. The Sewing Center phone number is (208)733-3344.

Knowledge of how to thread the sewing machine and sew a straight stitch are recommended.

Fabric & Tools Supplies:

Available through the Sun Valley Fabric Granary at 122 South Main Street in Hailey, with a 10% class participation discount, these items are needed. The retail price or range is next to each item.

- Book: *Teach Me to Make My First Quilt* by Pat Sloan, \$24.95
- Cotton Thread: Neutral color, \$8.99
- Fabric: Please reference the *Fabric Yardage Requirements*.
The fabric cost estimate for the quilt top is \$90.00.
This is seven yards at \$12.99 per yard.
- Pins: Range between \$7.99 and \$12.99
- Seam Ripper: \$6.99
- Fabric Scissors(ranges) or Thread Snippers: \$10.99

An alternate supply of fabric can be sourced through the 5 Bee Quilters Guild. Please call Jane Ulrich at (208)720-9753 to arrange meeting to select available fabric. This collection of fabric is donated and is a random assortment of patterns and colors.

The 5 Bee Quilters Guild members will supply the items below on the class days, for use in class:

- Cutting mats (18" x 24" or 24" x 36")
- Rotary cutters (45mm)
- Rulers (6" x 24", and assorted sizes of squares)
- Excellent quality fabric scissors
- Irons
- Ironing boards and ironing mats

The class will include a review of batting options for the middle(interior) of the quilt. Batting will be needed for the final quilt assembly.

There will be a class offered later in the year to learn how to add binding to the quilt.
